## 10 Tips for Visiting the Ancient City


1. **Plan Ahead:** St. Augustine is full of activities, so it's a good idea to plan your visit in advance to make sure you see everything you want to.


2. **Bring a camera** and capture your time in America's Oldest City.

3. **Walk through the historic downtown:** St. Augustine is home to some of the oldest buildings and monuments in America, so taking a stroll through the historic area will give you a deeper appreciation of the city and its history.

 4. **Visit the Castillo de San Marcos:** This iconic fort is the oldest masonry fort in the continental United States, and it's a must-see when visiting St. Augustine.

 5. **Visit Flagler College and be sure to take the tour:** you will want to see the 79 ORIGINAL Tiffany stained glass windows - one of the world's largest collections of Tiffany glass in their original location!

 6. **Stop into the Lightner Museum:** the collections do rotate, but their collection of Tiffany glass is stunning!

 7. **While you are at the Lightner,** head downstairs to the former swimming pool and have lunch at Cafe Alcazar - make your reservations ahead of time!

8. **Walk off your lunch with some retail therapy** on St. George Street

9. **Stroll by the waterfront** on Castillo Drive, and you'll spot the ancient city gates.

 10. **Finish up your day with a trolley ride.** The drivers will fill you in on all of the history of St. Augustine.
